## BreedLogic "IRLNext" Workshop

The BreedLogic "IRLNext" Workshop by ABRI aimed to develop a new breed registry software, engaging stakeholders from research to prototype testing. Key highlights included workshops on user objectives and adoption of six design principles emphasizing simplicity and member-centricity. Discussions explored product concepts, with an emphasis on enhancing features like mobile apps and Al-driven data analysis. Notably, Breedlogic, currently in testing, involves breed society members, beef, and dairy farmers.

What's next: A complete rewrite of ILR2, used by 182 societies worldwide, backed by a significant investment of \$5 million AUD (approx, R62 million), is underway. The Minimum Viable Product (MVP) is slated for mid-2024 release, followed by iterative updates leading to a full release in early 2025. Transition plans aim to onboard all clients by 2025.

ABRI is committed to engaging customers in the design process, ensuring seamless transitions, and delivering a robust platform that supports current needs and future growth.

Additionally, ABRI hosted a specific workshop on February 22nd, attended by 20 individuals representing various stakeholders, including society staff, breed society board members, and breeders. Notably, attendees included representatives from all the LRF breed societies and affiliated members. The workshop aimed to gather inputs from societies on the new software developed for use by society staff, as well as breeders, both stud and commercial, emphasizing a collaborative approach in tailoring the software to meet diverse user needs.
